HEMINGFORD, BOX BUTTE COUNTY, NEBRASKA: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF

Section 1. Title VII, Parking Code, Chapter 72, Section 72.22L is amended as follows:

Truck Parking

- commercial or farm trailers used in the transportation of goods, merchandise, produce, or freight over the public highways of the state. A truck tractor shall be defined as those vehicles separately licensed and used for the pulling of
- 2 normally hauled behind a pickup. including small utility trailers, flatbed trailers, fifth wheel trailers, horse or livestock trailers A truck tractor trailer is hereby defined as a commercial or farm trailer hauling the goods, merchandise, produce, or freight over the highways of the State requiring a separate title, but not
- ω It shall be unlawful for the operator of any truck or truck tractor to park such vehicles on any street within the corporate limits of the village except (1) between the hours of ten o'clock p.m. and six o'clock a.m. or (2) where the governing body, by resolution, designates otherwise. Provided however, such prohibited vehicles may park for the purposes of loading and unloading, and reasonable to load or unload. This does not apply to dump trucks, pickups, passenger sized panel truck, or other farm equipment that does not fit the definition herein. in which event vehicles may stop or stand for a period of time not to exceed what is necessary
- 4. a street intersection, on a crosswalk, in front of a private drive, or on the sidewalk It shall be unlawful for the operator of any truck, regardless of length, to park said vehicle within
- S The Governing Body may, by resolution, provide truck parking areas adjoining or adjacent to the business district and when such parking areas are designated, it shall be the duty of all truck operators to use such parking areas for parking purposes.
- 6 separate violation and subject to additional citations for each violation. Each 24-hour period that an operator remains in violation of this ordinance will be considered a
- 7 Violations of this section will be subject to the citation, fines, and impoundment as detailed in §72.80L, as amended
