VILLAGE TRAFFIC CODE

ORDINANCE #755

An Ordinance of the Village of Hemingford, Hemingford, Nebraska, amending Section 72.03, of Village Traffic Code, the Village of Hemingford; repealing the ordinance in conflict and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF HEMINGFORD, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 72.03 of the Village of Hemingford, Nebraska, Revised Traffic Code, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

§72.03 GENERAL PROHIBITIONS; EXCEPTIONS.

- (A) Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or when in compliance with law or the directions of a peace officer or traffic control device, no person shall:
- (1) Stop, stand, or park any vehicle:
 - (a) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
 - (b) On a sidewalk;
 - (c) Within an intersection;
 - (d) On a crosswalk;
 - (e) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone unless the Board of Trustees indicates a different length by signs or markings;
 - (f) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic;
 - (g) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure over a highway or within a highway tunnel;
 - (h) On any railroad track; or
 - (i) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.
- (2) Stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers:
 - (a) In front of a public or private driveway;
 - (b) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;
 - (c) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
 - (d) Within 30 feet of any flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign, or other traffic control devise located at the side of a roadway;
 - (e) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 75 feet of such entrance when properly signposted;
 - (f) At any place where official signs prohibit standing; or

(3)		while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers:	
	(a)	Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing; or	
	(b)	At any place where official signs prohibit parking.	
(B)	prohib	rson shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his or her control into any such pited area or away from a curb such a distance as shall be unlawful. RS 60-6,166) Penalty, see §70.99	
SEC	CTION 2.	That the original Section 72.03 be and the same is hereby repealed.	
SEC	CTION 3.	This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
