For any other issues that may require the sheriff and first responder's assistance please call 911 or the non-emergency Box Butte County Sheriff's Department.

Residents will automatically be opted in to receive text notifications but can opt-out from all text alerts at any time by texting "STOP" to 91896.

Residents can also sign up for text alerts at any time by opting into any of the following notification lists.

For Hemingford Alerts, text "HEMINGFORD" to 91896.

For Hemingford Pool Alerts, text "HEMINGFORDPOOL" to 91896.

After the initial keyword is sent, you will receive a confirmation message asking you to reply "**YES**" to verify opt-in.
