WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed into law on October 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, a Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by the Region 23 Emergency Management Agency, with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. of Lincoln, NE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hemingford Nebraska is governed by the Region 23 Emergency Management Agency with regard to disaster assistance.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the effects of disasters by increasing the disaster resistance of the region and participating jurisdictions located within the planning boundary by identifying the hazards that affect Region 23 Emergency Management Agency and prioritize mitigation strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards, and

WHEREAS, FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of <u>Region 23 Emergency Management Agency</u>, as well as its member jurisdictions in the form of a resolution and further requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the governing body of <u>The Village of Hemingford, Nebraska</u> does herewith adopt the Region 23 Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Plan Update in its entirety; and
