Jim Gardner made a presentation outlining the key provisions of the proposed budget statement, including but not limited to, a comparison with the prior year's budget. A transfer from the sewer department to the Village General was dropped, Hemingford is expected to receive State Municipal Equalization funds this year, and the total unused restricted fund authority is equal to \$627,000. The Village Tax Request will be decreased by .19 cents per \$100 of assessed value.
