Any pet over the age of 4 months shall be licensed annually. A certificate that the pet, has had its current rabies shot, effective for the year of the license will be copied and kept on file at the Village Office.

Snow Removal- Emergency Snow Routes Niobrara, Box Butte & Donald - No Parking between the hours of 2am & 6am on the day of the initial snow fall & the day following the end of snow fall.

Ice or less than six inches of snow: Intersections of Niobrara & Box Butte, around the school & Donald will be sanded.

Six inches of snow or more: Same as Less than six, with the addtion that Alleys that are used as main access will have priority over other alleys.

The Village Utility Workers are not responsible for clearing driveways.
