Canine:

Distemper/Parvo	\$23.50
Rabies	\$19.00

Feline:

Distemper	\$22.00
Distemper/Leukemia	\$38.50
Leukemia	\$22.00

Rabies \$19.00

All pets over the age of 6 months must be licensed. All licenses expire on December 31, 2018. These can be purchased at the time of the clinic or at the village office with proof of Rabies vaccination.

\$5.00 for Spayed or Neutered

\$6.00 for Non-Spayed or Non-Neutered
