Hemingford's Board of Trustees is seeking solutions to the staffing shortage and is open to all suggestions. The Board has considered contracting with Box Butte County Sheriffs Office for Law Enforcement services, and has ask Village Attorney to enter discussions with Box Butte County to see what such a contract could look like.
