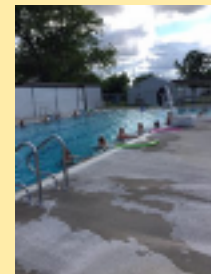

The Summer Reading Program Registration week is June 3- June 6

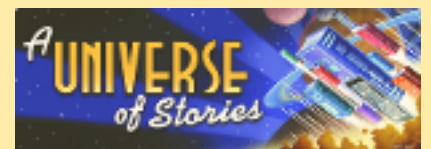
Library session are Wednesday at 2:00 pm - 3:00pm
