Friday - 12-5pm

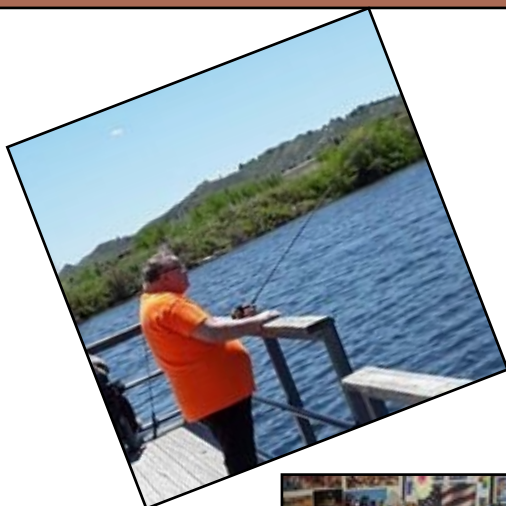
Saturday - 9-12 noon
